Jesmond Dene House offers style, a sense of history and a beautiful green setting yet is only five minutes from Newcastle city centre. Bordered by gardens, the house overlooks the small wooded valley of Jesmond Dene. Inside, the emphasis is on individuality, understated luxury and genuine, unfussy comfort.

The rich features of the Arts and Crafts house make a handsome backdrop to bold and light-filled rooms. There are huge windows, massive fireplaces, polished floors and an overall feeling of colour and warmth. Whether you're here to enjoy a meal, a stay in the bedrooms, to celebrate or for business, we aim to create an atmosphere where you can relax and feel a little bit special.

What we offer

Sometimes a restaurant isn't quite special enough. You want a little extra luxury, a little extra attention, a little extra cossetting. In truth, you want your own private restaurant. This is what we aim to provide with our private dining rooms: your own space, your own menu, your own team of waiters, your own sense of occasion. It might be a celebration, an anniversary, a get-together with family or friends, a business dinner, a way of saying thank-you or just a special moment you want to share with someone special.

With three individual dining rooms plus the Great Hall, we have a choice of venues whether for lunch parties, intimate suppers, celebratory meals, business dinners or receptions and formal banquets. Whether it's a romantic meal for two or a dinner for 100, each room offers privacy, comfort and style as well as a dedicated team of waiters. The three dining rooms overlook the wooded Dene or garden - two with access to a private terrace - while the wood-panelled Great Hall is a rather special setting for rather special occasions. Add a leafy backdrop, handsome architecture, rich colours and an attentive service, and our rooms make for a memorable occasion.

And, if you want balloons, a special cake, bows and ribbons, place cards, a magician, a jazz band ... that's not a problem.



Venues

Norman Shaw

Adjacent to the Restaurant, this light and elegant room overlooking the hotel garden and the trees of the Dene, can seat up to 18 guests for lunch or dinner. Steps lead down to a private terrace; a lovely spot for pre-dinner drinks.

John Dobson

On the lower level of the hotel, this room has natural daylight and access to a private terrace overlooking the trees of the Dene. It can seat up to 22 guests for a sit-down meal. Drinks can be taken on the terrace.

Frank Rich

Next door to the John Dobson, this room overlooks the Dene and can take dining parties of up to 12 guests.









Great Hall

A double-height room richly decorated with oak and silk panelling and featuring an inglenook fireplace, minstrels' gallery and lofty windows, the Great Hall offers a dramatic setting. With a separate, stone arched entrance - away from hotel and restaurant guests - it can hold a dining party of up to 34 guests around one table or up to 100 people can be seated at several tables for a formal dinner. Alternatively, around 150 guests can be invited for drinks receptions. The adjacent Reception Rooms, with dedicated bar, can be used as a private lounge.

For evening parties with entertainment, the Hall can take up to 100 guests for drinks and dancing. To avoid other hotel guests being disturbed, the surrounding 11 bedrooms must also be booked by the client or their guests.

Garden

A contemporary style garden borders the house. With its paved, lower terrace, charming pergola, striking colours and informal lawn, it makes a lovely setting for drinks receptions or photographs.



Food

Food is at the heart of Jesmond Dene House. We put great emphasis on creating fine, flavoursome dishes where there's both respect and passion for the ingredients. Menus are inspired by the seasons with produce from trusted and responsible sources, preferably local and, where possible, organic. Although the cooking style has an assured, classic foundation, it takes a fresh and spirited approach so that the quality of the ingredients, rather than fussy presentation, is allowed to shine.

Our aim is to be as flexible as possible so that the occasion feels truly personal, and you can concentrate on relaxing with your guests. You can choose to be as extravagant or as simple as you like: a multi-course banquet or cocktails and canapés, an intimate dinner party or lazy lunch. We have a choice of menus to suit different budgets or we'd be happy to create something that includes a favourite dish. We can also advise on reception drinks and wines.

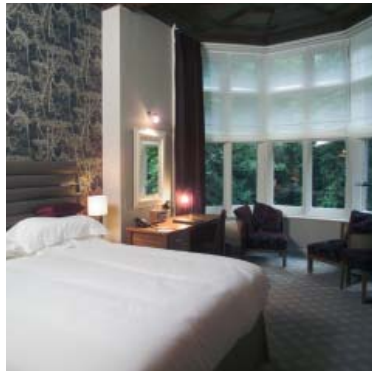


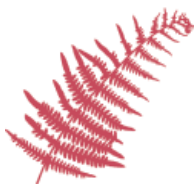
Bedrooms

The hotel has 40 individually designed bedrooms ranging from singles and small doubles to deluxe rooms and suites. No two rooms are the same - there might be a fireplace, timbered ceiling, grand window or private terrace - with views varying from trees to garden to rooftops. Furnishings are sleek, modern and uncluttered with luxurious touches of velvet, silk and suede. Bathrooms have a crisp, clean functionalism: big mirrors, big shelves, plenty of light.

Eight rooms, mainly junior suites, are in the New House, close to the Great Hall and a modern interpretation of the Arts and Crafts style.

Rooms are designed for both relaxation and work, with flat screen LCD television, cd/dvd player, digital radio, broadband access, desk space as well as fresh fruit, bathrobes, complimentary weekday newspaper and underfloor heating in the bathroom.
